## 2014 CONTRACT RULES - INSIDE AND OUTSIDE COMMERCIAL VENDORS

1. The vendor agrees to abide by all rules as detailed here by the Grand Valley Agricultural Society. Acceptance of any vendor is at the final discretion of the Grand Valley Agricultural Society
2. **Hold Harmless Agreement:** I, the lessee, agree that I shall indemnify and Hold Harmless the Grand Valley Agricultural Society and its members, agents, and employees from any claims, demands, losses, costs, damages, actions, suits or proceedings, by any party which may result from any act or actions or operations performed by me or my agents, employees, servants, or anyone for whose acts I/they may be held liable.
3. By signing the attached “Grand Valley Fall Fair September 19, 20, 21 2014 Vendor Space – Application Form”, you will be considered to have read and agreed to these “Contract Rules” .
4. Booths must be maintained and manned by the vendor, using qualified staff, during the operating hours of the Fall Fair. The booth must remain intact until closing date of fair on Sunday, September 21st 2014, unless contract specifies different operating hours or regulations.

Set-Up will be held on either Thursday, Sept. 18<sup>th</sup> 7-9pm OR Friday, Sept. 19<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 am – 11:30 am. Removal may not start until 3:30 pm on Sunday, Sept. 22<sup>nd</sup>. **Exhibit Hall will be open the following Hours:**

<b>Friday, Sept. 19<sup>th</sup></b>	6:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m.
<b>Saturday, Sept. 20<sup>th</sup></b>	9:00 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.
<b>Sunday, Sept. 21<sup>st</sup></b>	9:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.

5. If the vendor fails to comply with any of the terms of this agreement, all the rights of the vendor will be terminated. Any payment made by the vendor will be retained by the Grand Valley Agricultural Society as liquidated damages for breach of contract.
6. If the conduct of, or type of product being sold by the vendor is considered unacceptable by the Agricultural Society or fails to comply/meet the Ontario Public Health Standards then all rights of the vendor will be terminated. Any payment made by the vendor will be retained by the Grand Valley Agricultural Society as liquidated damages for breach of contract.
7. Grand Valley Agricultural Society will not be held liable for any lost, or damaged items during and/or outside of exhibit hours.
8. Free passes for vendors will not be provided by the Grand Valley Agricultural Society. As a vendor you must pay the standard entry rate to access the Fall Fair and/or their vendor space as follows:

Friday, Sept. 19 <sup>th</sup> -	Adults: \$7.00	High School: \$5.00	Elementary & Pre-School: Free
Saturday, Sept. 20 <sup>th</sup> -	Adults: \$7.00	High School: \$5.00	Elementary & Pre-School: Free
Sunday, Sept. 21 <sup>st</sup> -	Adults: \$8.00	High School: \$5.00	Elementary & Pre-School: Free

9. Vendor agrees to forward proof of insurance with Grand Valley Agricultural Society listed as an additional insured by Tuesday, Sept. 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2014 to the secretary at [gvagsociety@live.com](mailto:gvagsociety@live.com). (Food vendors must have a minimum of \$2 million liability).
10. If the Grand Valley Agricultural Society approves your application, you will be notified by email within 2 weeks of the submission of your application.
